Holidays are about creating cherished memories with loved ones and finding magic in the simplest moments.

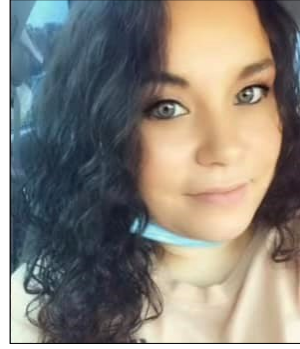

Thank you to the teachers and students for making the event so special for our residents!

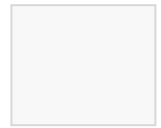


AWWW, SHUCKS!
