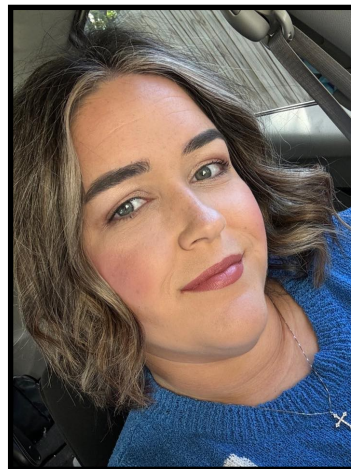

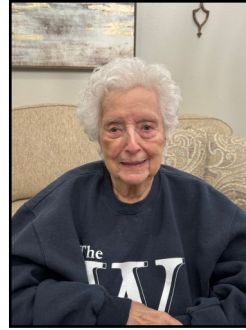

3. Pour mixture into muffin tins, and bake at 450° for 25 min.

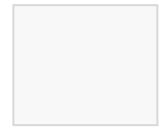


A SNOW DAY THE VERMILION WAY!
